Williamson Health is already a premier healthcare system providing high quality care. As Williamson County and the surrounding region continue to grow, it's imperative that Williamson Health do the same. We are committed to providing the highest quality healthcare to the communities we serve and these world-class additions and renovations will allow us to continue doing so for years to come. The project has already included the completion of the newly expanded and renovated Williamson Medical Center Boyer-Bryan West Tower, a new Cardiac Center featuring three state-of-the-art cardiac catheterization labs and an electrophysiology lab with pre- and post-procedure areas, the expanded and renovated Turner-Dugas Adult Emergency Department as well as the expanded and renovated obstetrics and neonatal care services, including a new postpartum unit.

Though incredible progress has been made, one significant need remains: a main hospital renovation to match the new Boyer-Bryan West Tower, including larger patient rooms, private patient elevators and updated medical technology.

But without help from community members like you, the rest of the project cannot be completed. Our campaign ends in 2026 and we look forward to building upon the success of 2025!

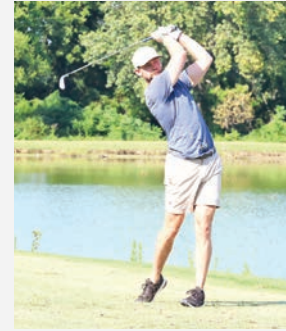

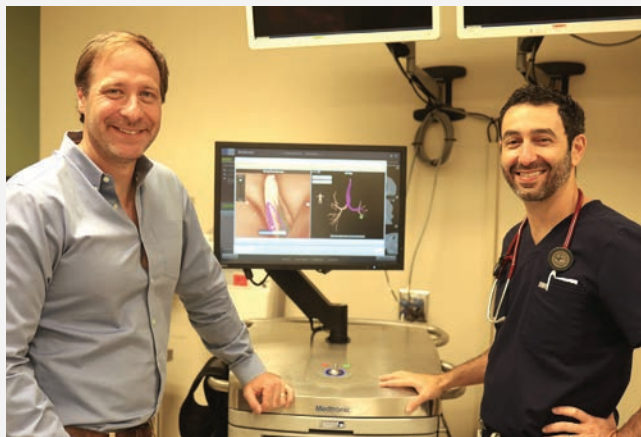
Men's Health Series

To meet that need, the Foundation raised funds to purchase a second therapeutic bronchoscope and a cryoprobe—vital tools in the early detection and treatment of lung cancer. A therapeutic bronchoscope is a specialized piece of equipment that allows skilled physicians to precisely navigate to suspicious lung nodules and collect tissue samples for faster, more accurate diagnoses. The addition of a cryoprobe would enhance the quality and the quantity of the potential cancer tissue being sampled.

We are thrilled to announce that by the end of December, we **more than tripled our campaign goal of \$20,000**—the cost of the equipment—and can contribute additional funds to critical needs of the healthcare system. **Giving Tuesday** is a shining example of our community coming together to support causes that truly elevate the level of care received at Williamson Health.

We understand there are many mental, emotional and physical challenges that accompany breast cancer. Post-surgery healing shouldn't be one of them! We partner with women recovering from surgery by offering a free 4-week reservation of a recliner, so they can recover more comfortably while gaining their strength back after surgery. Patients just have to reserve their chair, and it will be delivered, sanitized and placed wherever they would like in their home for four weeks.

We were able to provide 58 chairs for women recovering from breast cancer surgery this year.

Our community partner Head Springs Depot, a Franklin, TN furniture store, is partnering with the Foundation to store, sanitize and deliver recliner chairs for the complimentary 4-week program. We are immensely grateful for their support.

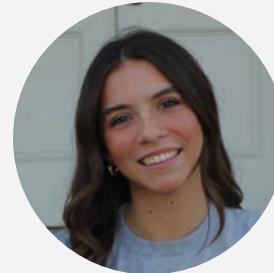
\$73,500 was given to 36 scholarship recipients this year.

Craig Ferrell Memorial Scholarship
